

CONDITIONS RECOMMENDED BY FINANCE COMMITTEE IESL NEW DELHI
FOR EDUCATION STIPEND

1. An amount, depending on the availability of funds is budgeted every year to be disbursed as Education Stipend to the wards of the Ex-Serviceman and widows. Changed circumstances have necessitated having a fresh look on the conditions presently laid down for entitlement to Education Stipend. Fresh recommendations which shall be applicable to claim the stipend shall be as under:-

a) Education Stipend shall only be entitled to all these Ex-Servicemen and widows who are members of IESL, New Delhi.

(b) Only on a ward of the Ex-Servicemen and widows shall be entitled to this stipend at any on a time.

(c) Ward of an Ex-Servicemen shall be entitled to stipend every alternative year, whereas war widows and disabled Ex-Servicemen (who are not fit to earn their livelihood) shall be entitled every year.

(d) Ex-Servicemen and widows whose total income per month, from all sources, exceeds Rs 3000/- pm shall not be entitled for the stipend. (Amended to read "Rs 5000/- for widows and to include Hav (Pre 96) also." - GC 14 Dec 09).

(e) Rates of stipend per annum shall be as under:-

(i) For Ex-Servicemen

Below Matric	-	600/-
Above Matric	-	800/-

(ii) For Widows, Disabled and Dependants

Below matric	-	800/-
Above matric	-	1000/-

(f) An additional amount of Rs 100/- shall be given to children who get above 90% marks in their last final exam.

(g) Rates of stipend as given above may be changed depending on the availability fo funds and number of applicants.

(h) An Ex-serviceman and widow who is getting any kind of stipend/dependent pension/Grant from any other source shall not be entitled to this stipend.

(j) A ward shall get stipend only once for each class. If he/she fails he/she shall not be entitled to stipend for the same class again.

- (k) Every claim shall be verified and signed by the District and State Presidents of the league without which, no claim shall be passed. This authority shall not be delegated to other office bearers by the State President.
- (l) An orphan ward of a late Ex-serviceman can also prefer claim provided he/she produces a certificate from the District Sainik Welfare officer. In case there are more than one children of an Ex-serviceman, only two children (the eldest and his youngest) will be eligible.
- (m) All the claims for Education stipend must reach IESL New Delhi latest by 30 Sept, every year. No claim after that date shall be entertained.
- (n) New application form, as recommended, is attached as Annx' II.
